- Riesling** (Rheingau, Germany) Winkeler Hasensprung, Kabinett glass 5.50 bottle \$21.00  
This is a classic easy-drinking wine from Allendorf; it's fruity, mild and versatile.
- Riesling** (Mosel, Germany) "Mineralschiefer", Estate bottled, QbA glass 6.25 bottle \$24.00  
This wine from Grans-Fassian is lively, tart-sweet and very accessible.
- Sauvignon Blanc** (Chile) glass 6.25 bottle \$24.00  
(DRY) This organic wine from Natura is fresh, crisp and richly flavored.
- Chardonnay** (California) glass 6.50 bottle \$25.00  
This wine from Bogle is fresh, rich and true.
- Pinot Grigio** (Italy) glass 6.50 bottle \$25.00  
(DRY) This crisp, light wine from Cavit can't be beat for easy summer drinking.
- Müller-Thurgau** (Franken, Germany) Iphöfer Kalb, Estate bottled, Kabinett glass 7.25 bottle \$28.00  
(DRY) This wine from Hans Wirsching is floral, a little earthy and elegant.
- Albariño**, (Spain) glass 7.75 bottle \$29.00  
Burgans produces this layered, fun wine--Robert Parker gives it 90 points!
- Riesling** (Rheingau, Germany) "Dragonstone", Rüdeshheimer Drachenstein glass 8.00 bottle \$30.00  
This delicious wine from Leitz is silky smooth and a touch minerally.
- Riesling** (Mosel, Germany) Ürziger Würtzgarten, 2004, Estate bottled, Spätlese bottle \$38.00  
Grown in red volcanic soil this unusual wine from Dr. Hermann is rich and a little spicy.

- Spätburgunder** (Rheingau, Germany) glass 6.25 bottle \$24.00  
Red Wine from Germany! This Pinot Noir from Allendorf is a dry, light bodied, full flavored wine.
- Carmenere** (Chile) glass 6.25 bottle \$24.00  
This wine from Hacienda Araucano is spicy with good structure and a dry finish.
- Grenache** (Calatayud, Spain) "Old Vine" glass 6.75 bottle \$25.00  
This wine from Los Rocas is a rich, medium dry wine - highly rated!
- Shiraz** (Australia) glass 7.00 bottle \$26.00  
A jammy, rich, big wine from Milton Park - 90 Points from Robert Parker.
- Pinot Noir** (Hungary) glass 7.75 bottle \$29.00  
This wine from Szremley is a find! It's full-flavored, a little juicy with a long finish.
- St. Laurent** (Austria) "Reserve" glass 8.25 bottle \$31.00  
This native-grape wine from Malat is juicy up front, it has soft tannins, and a nice dry finish.
- Cabernet-Merlot** (Hungary) "Sigillum Loienne" bottle \$45.00  
This Bordeaux style wine from Konyari is rich, juicy, dry and a little spicy. Great dark fruit flavors!
